It includes examination of all developments in legal aid and costs, criminal investigations, criminal law, procedure, evidence and sentencing. This edition covers developments from April 2008.

A review of all relevant case law will be included. The Autumn course will, in particular, consider:

- Criminal Justice and Immigration Act 2008
- Amendments to the Criminal Procedure Rules
- Magistrates' Court Sentencing Guidelines; guidelines on theft and dishonesty; and on death by driving
- Costs and contract developments

The seminar will include two hours of material relevant to the work of duty solicitors and accredited representatives - thus meeting their minimum training requirements
